Pharmaceutical Services

The pharmacy Department is a fully functional unit of Ghurki Trust Teaching Hospital. The aim is dispensing, counseling and provision of clinical and

technical services to both outdoor and indoor patients by the use of Hospital Management Information System (HMIS). Pharmacy and Therapeutic Committee

(P and TC) of GTTH is active and fully functional which has approved a generic based hospital formulary to ensure safe, cost effective and quality use of drugs. The department of Pharmaceutical

Services has sections such as: Procurement unit / Main Store, Outpatient pharmacy (OPD), Inpatient pharmacy (IPD) and clinical pharmacy. Clinical services are provided by respective clinical pharmacists at ward level. Drug related information is provided by pharmacists to health care professionals and patients as well. Department of pharmaceutical services also provides free of cost medicines to non-affording patients. It is also involved in teaching and training of the pharmacy graduates.


Cyberknife (Robotic Radio Surgery System)

A New Hope for Cancer Patients

In Pakistan every year around 300,000 new cases of cancer patients are diagnosed. The health facilities available in Pakistan to treat cancer patients are limited, therefore Ghurki Trust Teaching Hospital has started the construction of Cyberknife

(Robotic Radio Surgery System) the 2nd in Pakistan. Alhamdulillah, now building for this project is in its final stage. The installation of Cyberknife in Ghurki Hospital, is about to bring a revolution as it will provide free of cost international

standard treatment to cancer and non-cancer patients. This facility will cost around 400 million (40 crores) and it will be entirely dedicated to the poor and deserving cancer patients from all over Pakistan irrespective of religion and ethnicity.





Patient's Attendants Stay Area (Musafir Khana)

In Pakistan it is customary that not only the patient is admitted in the hospital but most of the family also accompanies the patient. Therefore hospitals always appear over occupied. The attendants have to go through a very tough time because the facilities are almost nonexistent. GTTH has come up with a unique solution to facilitate the attendants. "Musafir Khana" an accommodation facility for patient's families who travel from far flung areas. This facility will be able to accommodate around 400 people. Hopefully this facility will be available by the end of 2019, Insha Allah.





CHARITY WORK

Ghurki Trust Teaching Hospital is providing "State of the art" free of cost health facilities to non-affording poor patients without any discrimination. The same services are available for affording patients on very subsidized charges as compared to other hospitals.
